#### **GENERAL QUESTIONS**

# What does Orientation look like?

This is a three-day program that helps students meet peers, learn about the campus and engage in meaningful conversations. All first-year students will be in groups based on their First-Year Seminar (FYS) class.

### How long is Orientation? Is it mandatory?

Orientation is August 22-August 24. Groups will be on campus for about 7 hours, depending on your FYS group! It is mandatory, as involvement is essential to developing connections. Go to Elmhurst.edu/orientation for an overview schedule!

### What is an Orientation Student Leader (OSL)?

An OSL is a current Elmhurst University student who helps guide the group through every activity over these three days.

## Is there a fee for me to attend Orientation?
