

Private Individual Lessons

Whether you're a beginner or an experienced musician, the Elmhurst University Community Music Program offers private lessons to promote your growth as a musician.

The Community Music Program provides private instruction in voice and many instruments.

Our students vary in age and skill range. The recommended age for beginning private lessons is 8.

Students enrolled in private lessons must have their own instrument or have regular access to an instrument for practice. Traditional acoustic piano is preferred for piano students at all levels.

Private lessons are taught in four sessions:

Fall (12 weeks), Winter (8 weeks), Spring (12 weeks), and Summer (8-10 weeks). The lessons are scheduled weekly, for 30, 45, or 60 minutes (per the instructor's schedule and space availability).

Registration & Payment is due AFTER confirming time with faculty.
