Admission Requirements

The program is suited to students from many different educational backgrounds, including recent graduates. There are several business course prerequisites. You must have:

- A bachelor's degree from a regionally accredited U.S. institution or foreign equivalent
- Courses in financial accounting, managerial accounting and business finance (Requirement for all three courses can be satisfied by taking MBA Prep 300, an eight-week, online course. **This course is offered multiple times per year**).
- Additional application materials: Letters of Recommendation, Statement of Purpose, Résumé, Official Transcripts.

Because this is an accelerated full-time program, full-time employment is not recommended and must be approved by the MBA program director prior to beginning the program.

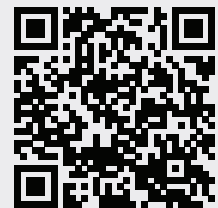
