Elementary Teacher Education program admission requirements should fulfill at least 5 of the 9 Areas of Knowledge in the Elmhurst University Integrated Curriculum (IC, general education requirements). The additional Areas of Knowledge to be completed are: Inquiry into Ethics & Justice (IEJ), Religious Studies in Context (RSC), Literature (LIT), and Fine Arts (FA). Such courses can be found on the Elmhurst University website (https://www.elmhurst.edu/admission/transfer-adult-students/) under "Transfer Guides" or through "Transferology." Students should have no more than two of the additional IC courses remaining for admission to the School of Education.

Students with a previously earned associate's degree will receive credit for all Elmhurst University AoKs through the Illinois Articulation Initiative (IAI). However, students who enter Elmhurst University without an associate's degree should have no more than two of the additional IC courses remaining for admission to the School of Education.
