

# **Elmhurst University Homecoming 2024 Parade Route**



**The Elmhurst University Homecoming Parade** begins at 10:00 a.m. on Saturday, Sept. 28. It will proceed west on Alexander Boulevard from Myrtle Avenue, south on Grace Avenue, east on Elm Park Avenue and north on Prospect Avenue, ending at Walter Street.

### **Street Closure Information**

- The parade route will reopen immediately at the conclusion of the parade, between 10:30 a.m. and 11:00 a.m
- Alexander Boulevard will close at 7:00 a.m. for tailgating and the Bluejay Block Party, and will reopen by 5:00 p.m.
